Commencement Date—Construction works for the new amenities are scheduled to commence on Wednesday 21st November 2018 and are scheduled to be completed before Christmas 2018

Where will people go to the toilet during the construction phase?

Because the old toilet will need to be demolished to make way for the new amenities, there will be no public toilets available during this period. Alternate public toilets are available at the lower recreation reserve Nundle and the Nundle Swimming Pool during opening hours. Where there are known major events scheduled within the Nundle Memorial Hall, alternate amenities will be accessible.
