Commonwealth Drought Assistance available from St Vincent de Paul.

The Parish is preparing to welcome a new Vicar, Rev Stephen Etherington, who will commence ministry in the here on 1 July. Stephen is a teacher, linguist and ordained priest of the Anglican Church. He and Narelle and family spent 40 years in the Northern Territory where Stephen worked with the Church Missionary Society as a teacher, Bible translator and pastor, ministering with Aboriginal communities. Stephen and Narelle retired to Tamworth in 2012.

Stephen has accepted the invitation to become Vicar of the Parish (Part time). He already teaches Scripture at Nundle Public School.

A service of induction, conducted by the Bishop of the Diocese of Armidale, Rev Rick Lewers, will take place at All Saints Anglican Church Nundle on Sunday 14th July at 10.00 am.
