Shower timers

Call into the Nundle Office and collect your shower timer—they are free! See if you can beat the four minute timer for a shower— it's surprising how quickly four minutes goes.

A ten minute shower can use up to 90 litres of water but by cutting back to a four minute shower not only do you save water but also energy used to heat the water for the shower.

There are also rebates available to residential treated water users for the following—water efficient showerhead,, dual flush toilet, swimming pool cover, rainwater tanks and plumbers audits See the council website www.tamworth.nsw.gov.au/waterebates or call into the Nundle Office for more information or to collect a rebate form

Nundle is currently on Level 4 water restrictions

- All residential outdoor use of treated / town / Council water is now banned.
- Council will cease to irrigate public parks, gardens, roundabouts and sporting facilities with treated water, but bore / groundwater can continue to be used where available.
- Recycled, greywater and rainwater can be used.
- Recycled, greywater and rainwater can be used. Rainwater tanks can only be approved by Council and a sign issued if they are stand-alone and not able to be switched to the treated supply.
- Trickle feed tanks that are connected to the town water supply for refilling cannot be used for outdoor watering.
- There is no irrigation of outdoor industrial and commercial green spaces.
- Cleaning of vehicle windows, windscreens, number plates and mirrors can be done for safety and regulatory purposes with buckets only.
- Pools cannot be filled or topped up.

Remember no matter what level of water restriction are in place animal welfare should never be compromised. Conservative essential water use to maintain the health, safety and hygiene of pets is recommended

Automated External Defibrillators

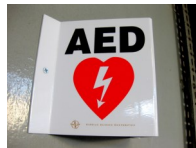
Do you know what an AED looks like? Do you know how to use one? AED's are easy to use and can save lives

At the recent CWA State Conference Nundle CWA was successful in having the Conference pass a motion "that the policy of the CWA of NSW be to lobby Federal Government for the promotion of a registered symbol indicating the presence of and AED (Automated External Defibrillator) and to ask the government to hold a campaign to make the symbol instantly recognisable Nundle Local Health Committee is also working to increase the awareness of AED's and their availability in the community

Most AED's have either red or green signage like the two signs below

In case of emergencies please ring 000 in the first instance. By doing this community organisations such as the SES and Frist Responders will be alerted and trained help will be initiated both from Nundle and other surrounding areas

AEDs (Heart starters) are available for the community at Hanging Rock Community Hall and Fossickers Caravan Park Office
