Nundle Australia Day Advisory Panel

In a move to simplify community involvement in Nundle's annual Australia Day celebrations, Tamworth Regional Council will call for Expressions of Interest from local residents to form a new advisory panel.

The change to advisory panel rather than operating as a committee of Council under Section 355 of the Local Government Act will create a simpler process for community members.

A maximum panel number of eight persons will make up the Nundle Australia Day Advisory, to work with Tamworth Regional Council Senior Place Manager Kay Burnes and other Council staff.

The new panel will have the role of reviewing nominations for the annual Australia Day celebrations in Nundle and make recommendation to Council of the determined recipients.

Council staff will continue to coordinate the community organisations and volunteers who deliver the annual celebrations in Nundle on Australia Day. The annual allocated budget for the event will also continue to be managed by Council.

Council is presently calling for Expressions of Interest, closing 22 November 2019. The appropriate form and an outline of the criteria for eligibility may be obtained from the Nundle Library during opening hours or by emailing Kay Burnes k.burnes@tamworth.nsw.gov.au.

It is expected the new advisory panel will be formed by late November 2019 to allow them to determine recipients of awards to be presented on Australia Day January 26, 2020.

The advisory panel will have a three year term.
