Nundle Library / Council Updates re COVID -19

Information is current at the time of publication (30 March 2020) Please check CNRL and TRC websites for updates.

Nundle Council Office & Library is staffed <u>for limited services</u> from 10:00am—2:00pm Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, and the Library is operating on Saturdays. The Office & Library are CLOSED THURSDAY & SUNDAY Ph 67693109

TRC services. The office is closed to the public, from today however, staff are still available to take enquiries and payments by email, or over the phone. Surcharges for credit card payments have been waived. Receipts will be issued by Tamworth office, so please allow time for you receipt to arrive.

Library protocols: For social distancing and hygiene, the Library can only provide the following at the time of publication:

- Computers: The Library rooms will not be open for computer access, but if social distancing is observed, patrons can access the WiFi from outside, signal strength allowing.
- **Returns** are **NOT** being accepted. Borrowed books will be automatically renewed on a continued basis. There are no fines for outstanding books, DVDs etc.
- **Borrowing** can still go ahead by reserving items online, or by calling ahead to check if the title is in the CNRL network. When your request is available, we will contact you where possible, or you can call in business hours and organise pick up. A library assistant can select titles for you, too, if you let us know your tastes.

<u>Note:</u> As returns are not being processed, **reservations will be confined to stock that is currently on the shelves** at Nundle or another CNRL branch. Stock will be transferred weekly, as usual.

E-books and other media can be downloaded free, from programs such as Borrow Box , StoryBox Library, RB Digital and Beamafilm—see the CNRL website for information.
